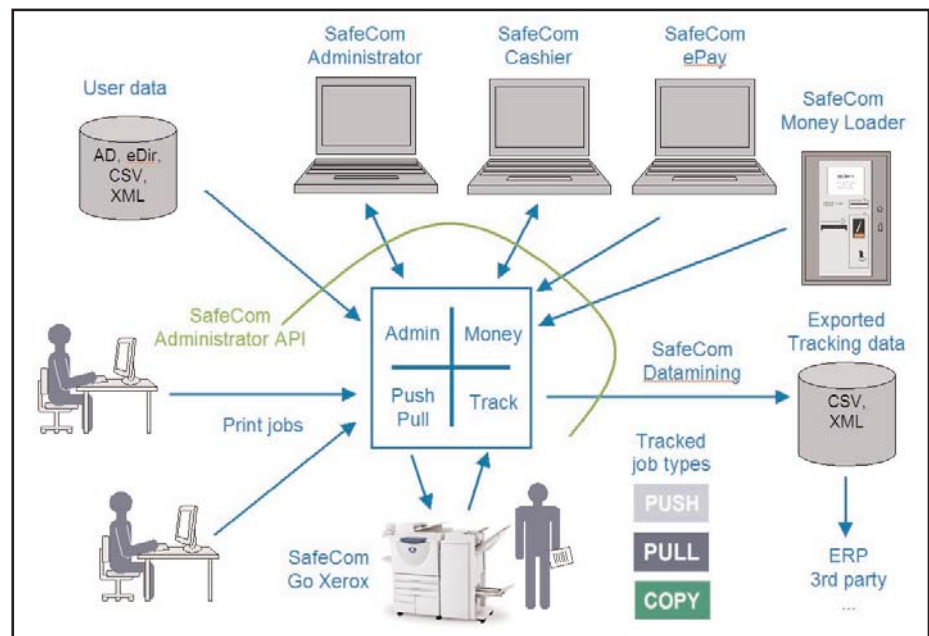

Overview

SafeCom is cost-efficient, secure and intelligent printing. With the introduction of EIP printing has become even more intelligent and user friendly. Documents follow users to their choice of printer thus turning any workgroup printer into a personal printer. SafeCom is scalable and can handle copy and print solutions in large and small organizations alike on one or multiple locations. With SafeCom you can track data on a user or department level, and it is also possible to charge users and clients for print and copy with SafeCom Tracking and Client Billing. Use SafeCom Rule Based Printing to enforce rules saving toner and paper.



Benefits

Cost-efficient: Balanced deployment of devices using cost-efficient workgroup printers for personal printing. SafeCom Rule Based Printing enforces rules that save toner and paper.

Secure: Pull Print with user identification at the printer by means of a card and/or code means no jeopardizing of document security. Print data is stored on the server until pulled by the user and is protected on the network with optional encryption.

Flexible: Documents follow users to their choice of printer allowing users to roam between locations and avoid downtime.

Controlled: Tracking of print and copy usage. Require authentication in order to grant access to copy, email, scan and fax.

Scalable: Solutions enable multiple servers to work together to support as many printers and users as required in various locations.

Enterprise ready: Central solution management and support for mission critical

printing with Microsoft Cluster Service support.

Revenue generating: Use recorded data for subsequent departmental invoicing with SafeCom Tracking and external invoicing with SafeCom Client Billing. Demand up-front payment for printing and copying; users can deposit money to their account either on the Internet via SafeCom ePay or by depositing notes and coins in the SafeCom Money Loader.

Customer Scenarios

Head of the IT department in a large corporation and in charge of the enormous printer fleet

Issue: John is head of the IT department in a large corporation and in charge of the enormous printer fleet. He has no overview over the company's total print costs, the number of prints, or the types of print jobs.

Solution

With a SafeCom tracking solution,

- John gets the possibility to track all copy and print jobs. He can see who prints what, how often, and how much.
- He can even send the bill for all print and copy jobs

back to the departments or users.

- Rule Based printing enables him to enforce rules for color jobs and duplex printing for specific users or applications saving even more money

Stockbroker

Issue: Bill is a stockbroker. Each day he works with loads of highly confidential information much of which needs to be printed to a printer that he shares with other people.

Solution

With a SafeCom Pull Print solution,

- Bill does not need to run to the printer each time he prints a document. He can relax because he knows all of his prints can be encrypted while traveling over the network to the printer.
- None of Bill's documents are printed before he himself goes to

the printer and logs in with his employee card and his PIN-code.

- With SafeCom Client Billing he can assign each print job to a specific client account and charge them the actual costs involved.

Student

Issue: Julie is a student at a major university. She often uses the public PC's in the university for her work.

Solution

With a SafeCom Pay and Pull Print Solution,

- Julie no longer has to stand in line at the printer getting annoyed with the person who just printed a 100 page document.
- She simply goes to the closest available printer, logs in using

her student card, and collects her prints.

- Julie does not need to keep small coins ready for copying. All print and copy expenses are paid over her student card, when her account runs low she can recharge it either at the cashier's desk, via the money loader or via the Internet.

Specifications

Server

Windows XP, 2003 and 2000. SafeCom License key code. Recommended: 1GHz CPU and 512 MB RAM. 1 GB of free disk space.

Database

The free Microsoft SQL Desktop Engine (MSDE) is distributed with SafeCom. In a SafeCom G2 multi server installation the master server must run Microsoft SQL 2000 and 2005 Server on either a Windows Server 2003 or a Windows 2000 Server.

Client

Windows XP, 2003, 2000, NT 4, 98 and clients running Citrix and Windows Terminal Service.

Recommended: 400 Mhz CPU and 256 MB RAM. 100 MB of free disk space. Printing from non-Windows environments via LPR.

 SafeCom Go Xerox utilizes the possibilities provided by EIP. With EIP SafeCom integrates with the touch screen on the Xerox device enabling user code authentication directly on the device. A card reader can be attached for authentication by card.

SafeCom Controller: All other devices
 SafeCom Controller is best combined with the SafeCom Front-end with LCD touch screen giving the same functionality as with SafeCom Go Xerox. Stand alone readers can be attached for "Print all at login".

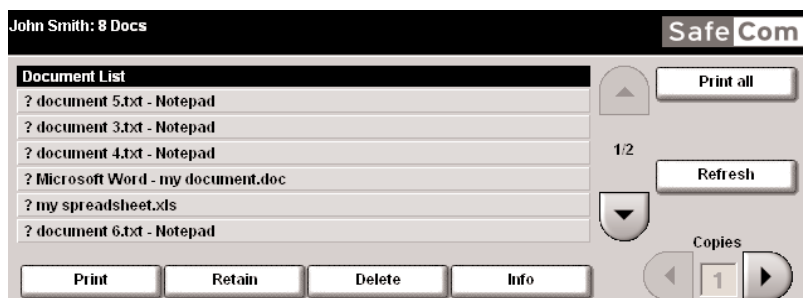
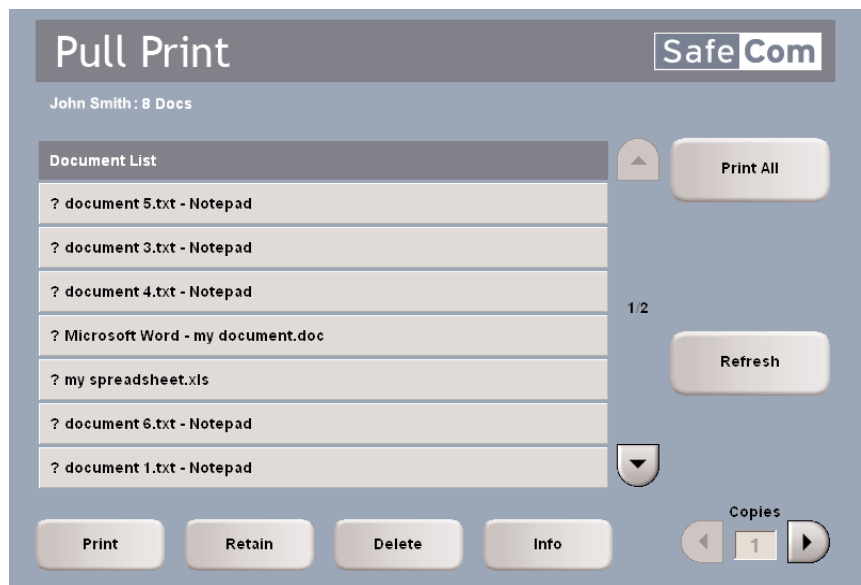
